The Air Hockey Championship CONTEST

Contest Rules

1. The contest is organized by the Old Port of Montréal Corporation and runs from August 11, 2023 to august 12, 2023.

CONTEST DURATION

2. Contest launch date: August 11,2023 at 10 am.

Contest end date: August 12, 2023, at 3: 00 pm.

ELIGIBILITY

3. This contest is open to residents of Canada aged 18 and over. Those ineligible to enter this contest are employees, agents, and representatives of the Old Port of Montréal Corporation, its advertising and promotional agencies, the suppliers of the prizes, products, and services related to this contest, and any other party directly related to this contest, including all members of their immediate families (siblings, children, parents), their legal or common-law spouses, and anyone living with these employees, agents, or representatives.

TO ENTER

- 4.1.
