

## Explore your Spring Break Photo Rally Contest

### Contest Regulations

1. This contest is organized by the OPMC (Old Port of Montréal Corporation, hereinafter “contest organizer”) and runs from February 27 to March 21, 2021, inclusively.

### CONTEST DURATION

2. The contest begins on February 26, 2021 at noon (12:00 am). The contest ends on March 21, 2021 at noon (12:00 am).

### ELIGIBILITY

3. This contest is open to residents of Canada aged 18 and over. Those ineligible to enter this contest include employees, agents and representatives of the Old Port of Montréal Corporation, its advertising and promotional agencies, the suppliers of the prize(s), materials and services related to this contest, and any other party directly related to this contest, including all members of their immediate families (siblings, children, father, mother), their legal or common-law spouses, and all persons living with said employees, agents and representatives.

### HOW TO ENTER

4. NO PURCHASE REQUIRED. To enter the contest, participants must fill out the following entry form:

5. Participants must complete the entry form with the first and last name of the adult (parent), the name of the child, and an email address and phone number. They must also include the photo and select one of the listed themes. Participants must complete one (1) form for every photo submitted up to a maximum of seven (7) photos for each participant. Themes are outlined in the Activity Guide available on the contest web page on the Montréal Science Centre website (<https://www.montrealsciencecentre.com/special-event/explore-your-spring-break-photo-rally>).

6. Forms and photos must be submitted between February 27 and March 21, 2021. No entries will be accepted after these dates.

7. Limit of seven (7) entries per participant.

8. Photos can be taken with any device (professional camera, smart phone, etc.) and all photo types are eligible.

### 9. ALLOCATION OF PRIZES

#### 10. Grand Prize

A selection committee composed of four (4) OPMC employees will select the winning photo from all photos received. Photos will be judged on the following criteria: originality, esthetics, and relevance to the theme.

**The winning photo will be announced on March 29, 2021, at 2 pm.**

The winning photo will also be put on display at the Montréal Science Centre at its reopening as well as posted on social media by the Science Centre.

Grand Prize:

- A digital camera valued at \$500
- A one-year family membership to the Montréal Science Centre (two adults and two children) valued at \$145. The one-year period will begin the day of the Science Centre's reopening.
- A pocket-sized programmable micro:bite device valued at \$25.

The winner will receive the grand prize by postal mail.

**The total value of the grand prize is \$670.**

#### 11. Secondary prizes :

Fourteen (14) winners will be drawn to receive one of the secondary prizes:

- One (1) of seven (7) Science Centre exhibition family passes (two adults and two children) valued at \$88 each, for a total value for \$616. Passes will be valid for a minimum of three (3) months following the reopening of the Science Centre.
- One (1) of seven (7) pocket-sized programmable micro:bite devices valued at \$25 for a total value of \$175.

No participant can win more than one prize.

Winners will receive secondary prizes by postal mail.

**The total value of the secondary prizes is \$791.**

**The total combined value of the grand prize and the secondary prizes is \$1,461.**

#### SELECTION OF THE WINNING PHOTO AND DRAWS

12. The winning photo will be announced on March 29, 2021, at 2 pm. An OPMC representative will contact the winner by email or by phone within three (3) business days.

13. Draws for the secondary prizes will take place on March 30, 2021, at 10 am at the OPMC, located at 333 de la Commune Ouest, Montréal (Québec). An OPMC representative will contact winners by email within three (3) business days.

#### GENERAL CONDITIONS

14. Chances of winning are based on the number of eligible entries received throughout the duration of the contest.

15. The prize package in its entirety holds no monetary value and cannot be extended.

16. The contest organizer, its employees, agents and representatives shall not be held responsible for any faulty operation of any technological component, software or line of communication, the loss or absence of network connectivity, or any incomplete transmission or transmission malfunction, error, or deletion caused by any computer or network that could thereby limit or prevent participants to enter the contest. The contest organizer, its employees, agents and representatives shall neither be held responsible for any damages or loss that could arise, directly or indirectly, in whole or in part, from downloading content from any web page or any software, or through the submission of any information related to entering the contest.

17. The contest organizer may disqualify any entries that are incomplete, submitted dishonestly, or that do not meet eligibility criteria. The contest organizer shall not be held responsible for lost or late entries or entries containing any kind of error. The contest organizers shall neither be held responsible for errors or omissions contained in the marketing materials related to this contest. All contest entries become the sole property of the contest organizer and none will not be returned.

18. The prize package must be accepted as described in these regulations and may not be replaced by or exchanged for any other prize. The prize package may only be transferred, in whole or in part, to another person with the written authorization of the contest organizer.

The persons on behalf of whom the contest is held shall accept no liability whatsoever in any event where their inability to act is the result of an event or circumstance that is beyond their control, of a malfunction of a transmission line or of a strike, lockout or any other labour dispute in their establishments or the establishments of organizations or firms whose services are used to run this contest.

The contest organizer reserves the right, at its sole discretion, to cancel, terminate, modify or suspend this contest in whole or in part in the event of a computer virus or bug, unauthorized human intervention, or any other occurrence beyond its control that could corrupt or adversely affect the administration, security, impartiality or normal operation of the contest, subject to the approval of the Régie des Alcools, des Courses et des Jeux du Québec, as the case may be.

The winner release from any liability the OPMC, its affiliates, franchisees, parent companies and affiliated companies, as well as their employees, agents and representatives for damages of any kind, including but not limited to, damages following any accident, injury, death, loss, delays, loss of enjoyment, mishaps, annoyances, disappointments or physical or mental anxieties or frustrations that may result from the acceptance or the use of the prize.

22. By entering this contest, any winners agree to allow, without any compensation, the contest organizer to use, for promotional purposes across any media platform including the OPMC's websites, their name, photograph, likeness, voice or statements related to the contest and the prize package.
