Lifeboat Mission Contest

Contest Regulations

1. This contest is organized by the OPMC (Old Port of Montréal Corporation, hereinafter "contest organizer") and runs from January 31 to June 11, 2021, inclusively.

CONTEST DURATION

2. The contest begins at noon on January 31, 2021. The contest ends at noon on June 11, 2021.

ADMISSIBILITÉ

3. This contest is open to teachers and teaching professionals (hereinafter "participating teachers") residing in Canada aged 18 and over. Those ineligible to enter this contest include employees, agents and representatives of the Old Port of Montréal Corporation, its advertising and promotional agencies, the suppliers of the prize(s), materials and services related to this contest, and any other party directly related to this contest, including all members of their immediate families (siblings, children, father, mother), their legal or common-law spouses, and all persons living with said employees, agents and representatives.

HOW TO ENTER

Participating teachers must also submit a photo of the activities that took place in the classroom as part of the Lifeboat Mission activity. They must also provide their contact information on the entry form to allow the OPMC to contact them should they be declared the winner. The winner's name (hereinafter "winner") will be drawn from all completed entry forms that are accompanied by a photo.

PRIX À GAGNER

5. The winner will receive a prize package that includes:
