



Visitor's Guide

Montréal Science Centre

We're so happy to welcome you back! This guide explains the health measures in effect at the Centre and includes some tips to help make your visit as fun and safe as possible.

Access to the Science Centre

- To enter the building, use the main entrance or the first exterior door located west of the Science Centre's central alleyway.
- The parking facility is open.
- We ask that you arrive for your visit at the time noted in your contract. Groups arriving too early cannot be admitted and will have to wait until 15 minutes before their visit time.

Preventive Measures

- Tickets can be purchased by phone or by email.
- Wearing a mask or face cover is mandatory in keeping with the public health authorities' current guidelines.
- When you arrive, you will be asked a few questions about your health. Visitors showing symptoms will not be allowed into the building.
- When you arrive, you will be asked to provide us with your institution's contact information on a contact tracing form. This information could be passed along to Montréal's public health authorities should someone test positive for COVID-19.
- Exceptionally, in the context of a school outing, teachers, students, and those accompanying them are exempted from having to present a vaccination passport.
- Disinfectant gel stations are available on site and handwashing stations (sinks and soap) have been installed in our exhibition halls.
- We are managing on-site physical distancing by reducing our visitor capacity and by scheduling staggered visits at fixed times. We are counting on everyone's cooperation to ensure current physical distance rules are followed.
- Inside the theatre, we will show you the rows where you can sit.
- We disinfect the seats and armrests in the IMAX®TELUS theatre between each screening.
- We deep clean all activity stations regularly and often in the exhibition halls.
- All shared materials in the *Fabrik* exhibition hall are disinfected regularly and often.
- We clean all shared spaces regularly and often, such as restrooms, and disinfect all high-touch areas with electrostatic disinfection equipment.
- Our employees are also asked to fill out a health questionnaire. Any employees showing symptoms are not admitted into the building.
- All of our employees wear personal protective equipment while on site.

Facilities and Services

- Restrooms are reserved for ticket holders only. Please follow all posted instructions to ensure proper physical distancing.
- Drinking fountains near the restrooms are accessible and cleaned regularly and often.
- Wheelchairs are available to ticket holders. However, to increase safety, we ask that you bring your own wheelchair whenever possible.
- The IMAX@TELUS theatre's snack bar is open.
- The Arsenik grignotines café counter is open.
- Food and beverages can only be consumed in specified areas.
- Our \$1 lockers are available, but quantities are limited.

Frequently Asked Questions

Which exhibitions are open?

All of our permanent exhibition halls are open: *Fabrik*, *Human*, *Explore*, and *Mini Mondo*.

Why can't we buy tickets on site?

Tickets can only be purchased by phone or by email. This is to reduce the risk of transmission between employees and visitors.

Will the restrooms be open?

Yes, restrooms are open to visitors and cleaned regularly and often.

Is the parking facility open?

Yes. The parking facility is open.
